As usual, this report gives an indication of some of the business that I have conducted on behalf of the CCG during April.

On 5 April I and other CCG colleagues took part in an informal meeting with members of several of our community groups to explore how we build on our current relationships to better engage with our public and patients

Our first Public Meeting took place on the afternoon of 18 April. We had a good turnout with over 60 members of the public in attendance.

I attended the NHS Clinical Commissioners (NHSCC) national event on 23 April and was invited to take place in a NHSCC / Core Cities network market place session run over the lunchtime period to showcase the four national networks the NHSCC runs and speak about the network to other CCG delegates. It provided opportunity to engage some of the wider core cities CCGs.

As I write this I intend to attend a meeting of the NHS Leadership Academy on 24 April, and the launch of the Health and Wellbeing Board and consultation event on 25 April, followed by the first meeting of the Board to be held in public.
