1. Introduction

This paper sets out the current key issues being addressed by the CET and the P&DG and provides a forward look to potential commissioning issues that will need to be addressed or will be subject to further work and involvement of the committee.

1.1 Commissioning Executive Team (CET)

- Agreed that the Urgent Primary Care Pilot be brought to a conclusion and the service combined with the GP Collaborative.
- Noted that Expressions of Interest for co-commissioning had been submitted to NHS England on behalf of the five CCGs in South Yorkshire and Bassetlaw
- Agreed that the Local Enhanced Hours Pharmacy Contracts be extended until 31 March 2015 with a new service to be formally tendered with an expected start date of 1 April 2015.
- Noted that proposals had been submitted for the Service Resilience monies in Sheffield to be approved by the System Resilience Group chaired by the Clinical Director.
- Agreed a revised specification for the Care Home Service and supported Care Planning

1.2 Planning and Delivery Group (P&DG)

- Agreed to the principle of utilising CCG clinicians to form an advisory service to inform and enable complex decision making by the CHC Eligibility Panel
- Request to be made for GPs to join the CHC eligibility panel
- Noted the timescales and progress regarding NHS England System Resilience bids
