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This report summaries the business that I have conducted on behalf of the CCG during March.

During the month I attended a meeting of the Sheffield Executive Board where the main focus for the discussion was Sheffield's approach to Public Service Reform since developing local approaches to public service delivery is now a major agenda. This session provided an opportunity to discuss progress in the city and the complexity of the challenge.

I also attended a meeting of the Health and Well Being Board where providers were invited to discuss the commissioning landscape in Sheffield. The next meeting of the Health and Wellbeing Board is scheduled to take place on 26 March.

Sheffield CCG hosted a meeting of Core Cities on 18 March where the main item for discussion was Devolution for Core City CCGs and what can be achieved for our populations.

The Annual Review of the Fairness Commission took place on 23 March 2015, to which the CCG was invited to participate.

As part of my national work with NHS Clinical Commissioners, I, along with senior Clinical Leaders, attended a further meeting in London with Nick Seddon, Special Advisor to the Prime Minister to discuss issues pertaining to the health sector. I also participated in a Webinar where the issue of specialised commissioning was discussed.

At the time of writing I am due to attend a meeting of the NHS Leadership Strategic Advisory Board and a consultative workshop, arranged by the Local Government Association, to discuss the future direction of Health and Wellbeing Boards.

A Governing Body Organisational Development session was held on the afternoon of 12 March where the OD programme content for April – August 2015 was discussed.

As members will be aware, an assessment and selection process was undertaken in order to appoint a new Accountable Officer to the CCG with the current post holder leaving the organisation on 31 March 2015. As no appointment was made to the role, arrangements are now in hand to re-advertise the post in the near future.
