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This report summarises the business that I have concluded on behalf of the CCG during October 2015.

My city-wide work during this period included attendance at a meeting of clinical leaders across the city to discuss the future of primary care services. Further meetings are planned in the coming weeks to continue this discussion.

The Accountable Officer and I attended the Sheffield Executive Board where an update on the Sheffield Devolution proposal was provided and the city's approach to Public Service Reform was discussed.

I attended the launch of the Best Start Strategy in Sheffield. This strategy has been developed in partnership and builds on the existing relationship with key partners from Sheffield City Council, NHS Sheffield Clinical Commissioning Group, Schools, Health, the Private Sector, Communities and Parents and Carers. The strategy is jointly owned by Sheffield City Council and NHS Sheffield Clinical Commissioning Group as we recognise that by working together we will be more effective.

I also attended a meeting with Lord Low of Dalston who spoke about the contribution advice services can make to improving health outcomes.

At the time of writing, I am due to attend a meeting of the South Yorkshire and Bassetlaw CCG Commissioners (CCGCOM), Health and Wellbeing Board and the Right First Time Programme Board.

As part of my national work, I will be attending the NHS Clinical Commissioners (NHSCC) Board where a key number of major topics will be discussed. During November the Accountable Officer and I will be attending the NHSCC Annual Members' event and the NHS England Commissioning System Leaders' event and we will provide an update on key topics at the next meeting.

As part of our organisational development programme, the next session planned for 12 November will focus on planning (finance and non-finance) and I would encourage your attendance at this important meeting.
