- 1.1 The Primary Care Commissioning Committee (PCCC) met in public on 15 July 2021 and the following key messages to Governing Body were agreed.

2. Key Messages

- 2.1 The Committee gave consideration to the specific financial issues relating to primary care presented in the H1 budget plan and approved the budgets for H1 noting the recurrent overspend on delegated budgets and the continuing work to quantify identify potential mitigations to offset this pressure.
- 2.2 The Committee recognised the limited workforce capacity and exceptional pressures on primary care at present and supported work to identify ways forward to mitigate these. The Committee wished to thank primary care staff for all their hard work especially during the staff shortages being experienced as a result of COVID -19 contact tracing and isolation requirements.
