

Consultation to change children's surgery and anaesthesia services in South and Mid Yorkshire, Bassetlaw and North Derbyshire

You said it was important to have:

-  Safe, quality treatment
-  Access to specialist care
-  Speedy Consultation
-  Fast ambulance/response
-  Good rehabilitation

Which services do we mean?

We are proposing to change a small number of services where your child's operation is:

- At night, or
- At a weekend, or,
- They need to stay in hospital overnight



This would affect 1 in every 10 children needing an operation in our region

For most services, most of the time, nothing would change. Children would still have operation in their local hospitals for things like:

- Tonsil removal
- Glue ear
- Setting of fractures/broken bones
- Any treatment that requires only a local anaesthetic but not being sent to sleep



For the following services:

The only services we are proposing to change.

We're also not looking to change specialist services for children with vary complex or multiple conditions needing care from specialist doctors and nurses. For these services, you would still go to Sheffield Children's Hospital as the only specialist children's centre in our region.
